Level 2

This class requires that participants are capable of dancing the basic formations without the need of a walk through. The instruction in the class will focus on improving the steps to a more advanced level and may introduce some of the new/and or unusual formations included in dances.

The workshop committee may reassign dancers to balance classes.

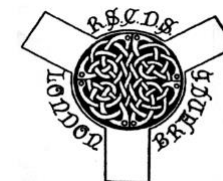
